#### **RESOLVED**

That the Internal Dispute Resolution Procedure appeal by AK be not upheld on the grounds that the Stage 1 decision of the Director of Service Support issued on 7 March 2014 was correct for the reasons stated in that decision notice – namely that there was no failure to address the issue of disability due to on-duty injuries allegedly sustained since there was insufficient evidence of any qualifying injury and / or because the Appellant prevented a full medical review by failing or refusing to authorise access to medical records deemed necessary by the Independent Qualified Medical Practitioner despite being requested to authorise such access.
