

# Environmental Working Group



## Purpose:

The Environmental Working Group exists to provide strategic direction, oversight, and organisational assurance on all matters relating to environmental performance across West Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service. Its core remit, as outlined in the Environmental Sustainability Strategy 2025-28, includes:

- Providing advice and guidance to the Fire Authority on environmental issues in line with WYFRS's ten environmental commitments.
- Monitoring and recording environmental issues arising from operational incidents.
- Reviewing and reducing usage of key utilities (electricity, gas, water) across the Service.
- Overseeing compliance with environmental licensing and legislation.
- Encouraging recycling initiatives and wider environmental awareness among staff.
- Offering a forum for staff to raise environmental concerns.
- Reviewing group membership annually to ensure appropriate representation.

This meeting is therefore both governance-focused and operationally supportive, providing a structured mechanism for environmental monitoring, improvement, and reporting—ultimately feeding into SLT and the Finance & Resources Committee.
